Shaanxi Shenfu - South Hebei Power Export Fugu (Three Gorges) solar farm is a solar photovoltaic (PV) farm under construction in Shixialiang village in Miaogoumen Town, Fugu, Yulin, Shaanxi, China.

The two existing coal-fired units of Fugu Miaogoumen power station, totaling 1,200 MW, were brought online in 2008. The plant was originally owned by Shenhua Group.
