

With the Corolla I had the AA 12v solar panel fitted (fixed) on the parcel shelf with the wire dropping down to the battery in the boot. As you know, the Cross just has a net cover which ...

Could it be a faulty solar panel? I've never heard of a faulty solar panel, but I guess it could happen. I've also tried different cables and the same thing happens. Any help will be appreciated. ...

The solar panel option means you can't get the car from Toyota with the heavier wheels for example. As far as breaking, it's tempered glass, which means if it breaks it does so into small ...

This doesn't make any sense. Toyota needs to recall and replace those low-quality plastic panels.

You've got this wrong, I spend roughly £7K for whole system including batteries- now could be slightly more probably 9K and put 7.2 kw system. Off grid system still comes with bypass ...

If you have solar panels and believe one may be broken or damaged, it's important to know the proper steps to take so you can fix the issue as quickly possible.

Big Toyota is dealing with me at the moment. I found the spot on my driveway a few weeks ago. Now that the sun has moved further north, the reflection is gone. Looks like it occurs ...

Yes, you can replace a broken solar panel, and your solar developer can do this for you. Do not leave a broken solar panel in place - arrange to get it replaced as soon as possible since a ...

Solar panels are hermetically sealed and should never leak unless they are damaged or defective. Bottom line is, Toyota introduced a new technology and installed a defective solar panel.

Once issues with the solar panel have been identified, the opportunity to repair it can often be examined. Several factors will influence whether repair is viable, including the nature of the ...

Yeah I saw as much as 73W being pulled from the 100W panel after a particularly high use night, and many 40's and 50's other days, so I think the panel is operating normally.

Is it just the glass over the solar collector that is broken (a little hard to see)? I'd think that a car glass shop could put a pane on there for a few \$hundred.
